The 16th Annual Conference of the Indian Section of International Society for Heart Research (ISHR) was organised by RUHS College of Health Sciences in Jaipur, Rajasthan from 15th to 17th February 2019. The theme of the conference was “Structural Heart Disease - Bench to Cath Lab”. Also, there were two prize sessions for recognising the

distinguished young scientists N K Ganguly Award (Clinical Cardiology) and N S Dhalla Award (Basic Cardiovascular Research). In addition, there were seven prizes with certification for outstanding paper and e-poster presentation. The conference was awarded 6 CME credit hours by Rajasthan Medical Council.
